He said that the central Government has set sustainable Development Goals to reduce the number of people affected by HIV/AIDS and to reduce the number of deaths. Union Minister Shri J.P.Nadda said that the HIV and AIDS (Prevention and control) Act 2017was implemented. This Act is helping in preventing and controlling the spread of HIV/AIDS. This Act

strengthened the legal human rights of people infected and affected by HIV/AIDS. This Act is also an attempt to protect the rights of health service providers. He said that people affected HIV/AIDS are being treatment free of cost.

Union Minister Shri J.P.Nadda said that Madhya Pradesh is at the forefront in the country in the expansion of medical education & health facilities. He also praised Madhya Pradesh for this.

Chief Minister Dr Mohan Yadav expressed gratitude to Union Minister Shri J.P. Nadda for organizing this program in Indore on the occasion of World AIDS Day. He said that this event will help in solving the challenges and achieving the global goal of ending HIV/AIDS by the year 2030 by bringing together communities, youth, beneficiaries and various organizations. Activities at the State level: Mass Media Campaign- Various activities done before and after the World AIDS Day as part of the awareness campaign

Audio Spots through FM Radio, Audio Spots in Community Radios, <u>5.97 Crore</u> free broadcasting of SMSs on 30 Nov and 01 December (World AIDS Day 24) through Jio, Idea, Voda and Airtel telecom company, Foot Overbridged, Gantries, City Buses, LED Screens at Railway Station

Sensitization for Frontline worker and Health care provider:-Special sessions were conducted to sensitize Nursing staff, Medical & Para-Medical, Accredited Social Health Activists (ASHA) and Auxiliary Nurse Midwives (ANM) about their crucial role in disseminating information, supporting affected individuals, and facilitating testing. Training programs aimed at enhancing their understanding of HIV/AIDS issues were conducted to empower them as community health advocates.





Candlelight Vigil: As evening fell, a solemn candlelight vigil was organized, symbolizing remembrance and solidarity with those affected by HIV/AIDS. The vigil served as a poignant reminder of the

importance of compassion and support in the face of the epidemic.



Health Camp: In collaboration with local health authorities, a health camp was organized to provide free HIV testing, counseling, and



distribution of informational materials. This initiative aimed to encourage proactive health-seeking behavior and reduce barriers to testing.
